6		A+	----	----	100.0	An o-line haul (3 picks) for the ages; o-line before long term QB - smart, then again, maybe Fields is the long term guy; good WR/LB pick value too.
1		A	----	----	96.5	When you get the best QB since A. Luck and a top flight WR in the top 10 you've won. Bolstered O-Line and D-Line too. Success.
9		A	----	----	96.5	GM Rosen gets usual draft heist stealing arguably the best 2 CB's in the draft at #'s 22 and #40. FSU WR Wilson nice sleeper at #185.
20		A	----	----	96.5	Chose the best WR (Harrison) in the draft in years, then got needed edge rusher Robinson late in the first round (27th) in massive 12 player haul.
26		A	----	----	96.5	QB Daniels at #2, great; a steal of the draft at #36 with DL Newton; were one more O-Lineman away from getting our top grade.
7		A-	----	----	93.0	Nabbed high upside, need w/ CB's Wiggins at #30 and Tampa at #130; plus big need at Tackle in 2nd; classic Ravens winning draft...again.
14		A-	----	----	93.0	Weak value w/OT Morgan at #25; but 6 good defensive picks in 11 player heist; up to old tricks with value pick QB Pratt in 7th.
24		A-	----	----	93.0	Bolsted weaknesses at QB, o-line & WR w/ first 5 picks; puzzling "Belichickian" QB Milton pick in 6th after drafting high upside Maye at #3.
2		B+	----	----	89.5	Got the top rated Safety (Nubin) and most productive WR (Nabers) in brief 6 pick stint. Added to all 6 of their weakest roster positions.
11		B+	----	----	89.5	TE Bowers great value at #13, but TE 1st rounders two years in a row? Good o-line value in 2nd/3rd with C/G Powers-Johnson and T Glaze.
28		B+	----	----	89.5	#28 pick, WR Worthy (fastest player in draft) is boom/bust with limited route tree; we like the other picks bolstering o-line and secondary.
31		B+	----	----	89.5	Made hay with first four picks in the top 92 filling o-line, WR and defensive holes; WR McMillan pick (#92) has upside written all over him.
10		B	----	----	86.0	Solid first 3 picks considering no 3rd and 4th round picks filling major weaknesses at OT & CB; QB Rattler in the 5th round is a steal with upside.
21		B	----	----	86.0	Overdrafted 8-start OT Mimms but got Burrow WR & TE help; continued to bolster DL as they did in free agency to repace loss of stud DT Reader in FA.
22		B	----	----	86.0	Selected highly needed WR and OT help early; then found defensive front 7 help to fix chronically weak run defense; nothing fancy beyond Alt/McConkey.
17		B-	----	----	82.5	Value & more value with CB's Arnold (#24) & Rakestraw (#61), then 6th rounders LSU DT Wingo & BC OT Mahogany; Canadien OT pick iffy.
18		B-	----	----	82.5	Two trades down then poor value WR Coleman at #33; recovered with Utah S (#60) & Duke DL (#95) in 10-pick class to bolster weakened roster.
19		B-	----	----	82.5	Weak value w/ QB Nix at #12 followed by great value given no 2nd rounder; got Nix 3 weapons; Missouri CB in 5th is one of the drafts best steals.
23		B-	----	----	82.5	Decent performance highlighted by 5th round, #158 DL Kamara who we are high on; not sure of the need for another RB - TN game breaker Wright.
27		B-	----	----	82.5	Took Michigan RB Corum a bit high at #83 since he is not a great receiver but nice 6 player front-7 haul for the "D" to offset DT Donald retirement.
5		C+	----	----	79.0	Hawks fill weakness at DL and interior o-line here; Auburn CB James good value in 6th at pick number 192.
8		C+	----	----	79.0	Offensive mindset with 2 linemen and 2 WR's in first 5 picks; good value with WR Mitchell at #52.
15		C+	----	----	79.0	Loved OT pick in 1st (FA OT Smith has age & injury history) & upside small school WR in 2nd; not big on 2 RB picks later on when you have stud Hall.
16		C+	----	----	79.0	Stunning QB Penix pick at #8; great for team with aging QB but they'll waste 3 years of his low priced rookie contract w/ Cousins locked in for 3 years.
30		C+	----	----	79.0	We thought they overreached for WR Pearsall at #31 followed by good picks plugging weaknesses at interior offensive line and cornerback.
32		C+	----	----	79.0	Got their man QB McCarthy with minimal trade loss; major draft heist with Edge Turner at #17; other picks were quite disappointing in our view.
3		C	----	----	75.5	Decent first 4 picks but some falloff after; grabbed low end linemen; nothing overly exciting and not sure about Louisville RB late.
12		C	----	----	75.5	Talented team with minimal needs takes half of their 6 picks in defensive front-7; not bad considering no 1st round pick.
13		C	----	----	75.5	Overdrafted OT Latham at #8 after stud Alt taken at #5; then overdrafted Sweat in 2nd; GM Carthon made some good value picks late though.
25		C	----	----	75.5	Mayonnaise sandwich draft after LSU WR Thomas at #20 with nothing standing out but they did get 9 picks so some depth gained.
29		C-	----	----	72.0	Respectable, needed Tackle & Guard picks early but mayonnaise sandwich picks after that; underwhelming results unlike past Dallas stellar drafts.
4		D+	----	----	68.5	Three of 1st four picks on offense helps QB Young but overdrafted the 1st two, WR Leggett and RB Brooks; poor value and unexciting.
